


Airport North Precinct work: June 2020

The NSW Government is upgrading roads north of Sydney's Kingsford Smith Airport to improve traffic flow and connections to and from the Airport and Port Botany.

The priority for this month is to complete the eastern side of O'Riordan Street and move traffic on to the newly built southbound lanes. The single southbound lane will be in place until 5am Monday 15 June.

From Monday 15 June we will be moving the work zone into the middle of O'Riordan Street to complete the central median and drainage work. These traffic changes will be in place over the next few months. These activities will require temporary traffic changes, which may affect travel times.



From **Thursday 26 June** and through July we will be closing sections of the northbound lanes during weekend closures (**9pm Friday to 5am Monday**) to complete asphalt work. This may restrict access to side roads. Access to properties will be maintained throughout the work.

General work which will be occurring during June 2020 are:

- use of site compound and work zones including excavation and material removal
- service identification, relocation and cutovers, including utility trenching and drainage work, installing light poles, traffic loops, protection slabs, pit lids and traffic signals
- pavement work including concrete pouring, removal of old kerb and guttering, milling the road, laying and compacting sublayers and asphalt work
- traffic management and roadworks including sign and barrier adjustment, temporary traffic changes and pedestrian detours including the temporary traffic changes along O’Riordan Street

Standard construction hours for the **Airport North project** during COVID-19 are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Sunday**. Our out of hours working hours are **7:30pm to 5am, Monday to Sunday**.

There may be some noise, vibration and disruption associated with this work. Machinery and equipment used may include trucks, excavators, paving machines, rollers, lighting towers, road saws, plate compactors, vacuum trucks, grinders, cranes, elevated work platforms, chainsaws, mulching machines, light vehicles, hand tools, concrete trucks and equipment. We will continue to make every effort to minimise the impacts to the local community.
