



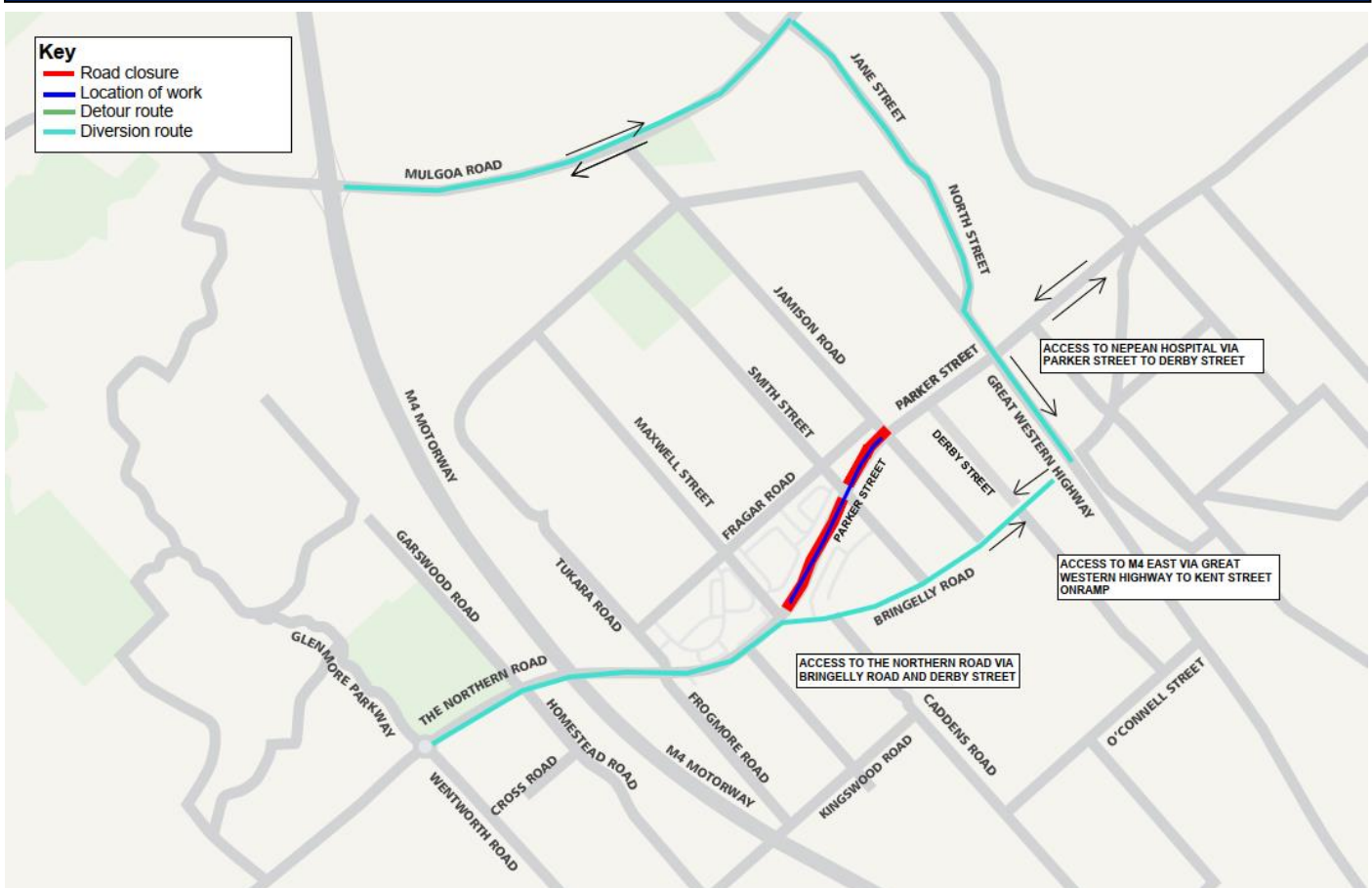
Two weekends closure of The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road, South Penrith from Friday 5 March and Friday 19 March

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. To progress important work on this section of the project, we need to temporarily close The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road on two weekends. Detours will be in place as per the maps below.

We will close The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road on the following weekends:

- From Friday 5 March to Monday 8 March
- From Friday 19 March to Monday 22 March

Upcoming weekend road closures

In order to carry out this work we will be temporarily closing The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road from **8pm Friday 5 March** to **5am Monday 8 March**, and from **8pm Friday 19 March** to **5am Monday 22 March** weather permitting.

During these closures, there will be no access to and from The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Jamison Road with the exception of local residents who will be directed safely by traffic control. Detours for local residents will be in place with access to Smith Street west via Bringelly Road and Smith Street east and access to Smith Street east will be via Jamison Road and Bringelly Road. Local access to Nepean Hospital will be maintained.

If travelling from **outside these areas**, please use the **detour** routes as follows:

Need to travel south along The Northern Road (A9) to Glenmore Park and Campbelltown:

- turn left onto Great Western Highway at Kingswood, right onto Bringelly Road and then left onto The Northern Road

Need to travel north along The Northern Road (A9) at South Penrith:

- turn right onto Bringelly Road, left onto The Great Western Highway, and then right onto Parker Street

Need to travel west from Cranebrook, use Andrews Road:

- turn left onto Mulgoa Road and then join the M4 Motorway

Need to travel east, use the Great Western Highway to:

- turn right onto Gipps Street/Kent Road to join the M4 Motorway

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?

You may experience some noise and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
