



Update: Night work and closure of The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Derby Street, South Penrith now on Friday 26 and Sunday 28 February

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith

We wrote to you previously to tell you The Northern Road would be closed between Maxwell Street and Derby Street from Friday 19 and Saturday 20 February 2021. Due to forecast bad weather this weekend, we will now carry out this closure on **Friday 26 and Sunday 28 February 2021**. Detours will be in place as per the map below.



Upcoming night work and road closures

We will be temporarily closing The Northern Road between Maxwell Street and Derby Street from **7pm Friday 26 February to 8am Saturday 27 February** and from **7pm Sunday 28 February to 5am Monday 1 March**, weather permitting.

Detours will be in place to access Smith Street west via Maxwell Street and Fragar Road and access to Smith Street east will be via Derby Street and Bringelly Road, access to Jamison Road east and Stafford Street east will be via Derby Street and Bringelly Road and access to Jamison Road west and Stafford Street west will be via Derby Street and Colless Street.

The following changes will be in place after this work from **5am Sunday 1 March** weather permitting:

- The northbound traffic on The Northern Road will be put onto the newly built northbound lanes between the Maxwell/Bringelly intersection and Jamison Road

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?

You may experience some noise and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
