



Night work and closure of The Northern Road between Tukara Road and Jamison Road, South Penrith on Friday 12 and Saturday 13 February

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith

Transport for NSW is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith. To progress important work on this section of the project, we need to temporarily close The Northern Road between Tukara Road and Jamison Road, and a small section of Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road.

Upcoming night work and road closures

To minimise impact on road users, this work will take place at night from **8pm Friday 12 February to 8am Saturday 13 February** and from **8pm Saturday 13 February to 8am Sunday 14 February** on The Northern Road and from **7pm to 8am on Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road**, weather permitting. If we are unable to do this work due to inclement weather, this work will be done the following weekend of **Friday 19 and Saturday 20 February**.

Detours will be in place with access to Maxwell Street from The Northern Road via Jamison Road and Tukara Road. Tukara Road will be left in only. Access to Bringelly Road from The Northern Road will be via Jamison Road. Access to Smith Street west will be via Tukara Road and access to Smith Street east will be via Jamison Road, Kingswood Road, Caddens Road and Bringelly Road.

Access to the businesses located on Aspen Street will be available via the Maxwell Street entrance. For motorists travelling from the eastern side of The Northern Road, access will only be available to Maxwell Street via Fragar Road from Jamison Road.

Frogmore Road will be left out only and there will be no right turn into Frogmore Road from The Northern Road during this closure.

The following changes will be in place after this work from **9am Sunday 14 February**, weather permitting:

- **East of the roundabout on Maxwell Street** – there will be a dedicated left turn slip lane, two lanes going straight and two right turn lanes
- **West of the roundabout on Maxwell Street** – traffic will be moved to the newly constructed lanes to allow us to complete work on the other eastbound lane.
- **Westbound from Bringelly Road** - there will be a dedicated left turn slip lane from Bringelly Road to The Northern Road, one lane going straight and two right turn lanes at the intersection
- Northbound traffic on The Northern Road will be put onto the newly built northbound lanes between the M4 intersection and Maxwell Street.
- Pedestrian access at the intersection will be open with a north / south crossing on Bringelly Road and Maxwell Street and an east / west crossing on northern side of Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road to cross The Northern Road

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.

How will the work affect you?

You may experience some noise and every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using lighting towers only when necessary
- directing noise generating equipment away from resident properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, and power and hand tools.
