



Out of hours work continuing on The Northern Road, South Penrith from Monday 2 September 2019

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith



As part of the upgrade, Roads and Maritime Services needs to carry out additional out of hours work along The Northern Road, local roads, the M4 interchange bridge and the M4 Motorway.

This work will involve:

- building retaining walls and bridge structures
- installing temporary access ramps and concrete platforms
- utility work including investigations, cutovers, underboring, removing overhead lines and installing drainage
- setting up and adjusting barriers and signage
- installing temporary lanes, building road surface layers and line marking
- general earthwork and landscaping.

Out of hours work

To minimise the impact on road users, we will carry out this work at night from **Monday 2 September 2019 to Sunday 1 December 2019**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be from 10pm to 8am on Fridays, from 10pm to 9am on Saturdays and from 10pm to 5am Sundays to Thursdays.

There will be up to **five night shifts per week**, with no more than **three** consecutive night shifts carried out in the same location.

We may also need to work on weekends between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays and Sundays**, weather permitting. Residents will be notified directly of any additional night work.

What to expect

- Some activities such as saw-cutting and breaking concrete may be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible and we have instructed workers to keep noise to a minimum.
- Every effort will be made to minimise impact on residents by using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices and monitoring noise at night.
- We have installed temporary footpaths between Bringelly Road and Jamison Road.
- There is restricted pedestrian access between Frogmore Road and Bringelly Road.

Traffic changes

For the safety of motorists and workers, most of the work will take place behind concrete barriers. There will be some traffic changes and temporary lane closures which may affect travel times.

Detours will be in place which may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of signs and traffic controllers.
