Work continues on The Northern Road between Eaton Road, Luddenham and Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park

Transport for NSW has recently opened two lanes each way of the upgraded The Northern Road between Mersey Road, Bringelly and Eaton Road, Luddenham. We will continue work on The Northern Road from Eaton Road to Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park from **1 October to 20 January 2021**.

As part of this work, we will continue to carry out work across the project area which includes:

- installing, removing and maintaining traffic control measures such as barriers
- investigating and relocating utilities
- earth work and road surface work
- line marking and removal
- general maintenance of work area
- reopening Adams Road on Wednesday 30 September

As part of this work, there will be further changes to traffic realignment along The Northern Road and at times there will be full closures of The Northern Road and some of the local roads to allow work to continue. Diversions will be in place during the work.

We will provide further updates and information about these planned closures, to directly impacted residents and businesses before the work.

In the last few months, we have completed several project milestones. These include:

- turning on the new traffic lights at Littlefields Road and The Northern Road
- traffic realignments along The Northern Road
- removing the roundabout and turning on the new traffic lights at the intersection of The Northern Road and Elizabeth Drive
- completing u-turn bays at Elizabeth Drive and on The Northern Road opposite the Defence Establishment Orchard Hills

In line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of Coronavirus and social distancing, all work on site is being carried out at a safe physical distance where possible and necessary hygiene practices will continue to be observed. To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on weekends and public holidays

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists and to minimise the disruption to the road network, we will need to carry out some work outside standard construction hours which are now Monday to Sunday, 7am to 6pm (inclusive of public holidays).

When work is to be carried out outside standard construction hours, we will notify directly impacted residents and businesses.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work; however, we will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- adapting our construction methods to reduce noise impact as much as possible
- arranging work in stages at different locations.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and motorists. Please adhere to the displayed speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
