




# Night work and ramp closures on the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road, South Penrith from Wednesday 13 February

The Australian and NSW Governments are delivering the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

The Northern Road and M4 Motorway detour map and work location



Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work to build a new bridge over the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road, South Penrith. To minimise the impact on road users, some of this work will take place at night.

The eastbound off ramp and westbound on ramp at the M4 Motorway interchange on The Northern Road will be closed from **10pm to 5am** on the following dates, weather permitting:

- **Wednesday 13 February**
- **Thursday 14 February**
- **Wednesday 20 February**
- **Thursday 21 February**
- **Wednesday 27 February**
- **Thursday 28 February**

Work includes installing temporary barriers, building temporary access roads, changing signage and line marking.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times and will involve cranes, saw cutting, loading and unloading trucks and hand tools. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents by:

- adapting our construction methods to reduce night work impacts as much as possible
- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices
- monitoring noise at night.

## Traffic changes

Detours will be in place during the ramp closures. This may affect travel times.
