




## Night work and traffic changes on The Northern Road upgrade, South Penrith from Friday 22 February 2019

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith.

Utility installation on Jamison Road at the intersection with The Northern Road (Parker Street) will take place on **Friday 22 February from 10pm to 8am, Saturday 23 February from 10pm to 9am and Sunday 24 February from 10pm to 5am**, weather permitting.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but every effort will be made to minimise impacts on residents by:

- adapting our construction methods to reduce night work impacts as much as possible
- changing work locations to minimise continuous impact on the same groups of residents
- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices and monitoring noise at night.

## Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place at night to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and motorists. Detours will be in place via Derby Street and Fragar Road/Bringelly Road.

Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.
