




Night work and traffic changes on The Northern Road upgrade, South Penrith from Friday 11 January 2019

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith. Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith.

As part of this work, utilities will be installed along The Northern Road and Bringelly Road, South Penrith.


Utility installation along Bringelly Road, South Penrith (Map 1) will take place on **Friday 11 January from 10pm to 8am, Saturday 12 January from 10pm to 9am and Sunday 13 January from 10pm to 5am**, weather permitting.

Utility installation along The Northern Road between Frogmore Road and Bringelly Road (Map 2) will take place on **Friday 18 January from 10pm to 8am, Saturday 19 January from 10pm to 9am, Sunday 20 January from 10pm to 5am, Friday 1 February from 10pm to 8am, Saturday 2 February from 10pm to 9am and Sunday 3 February from 10pm to 5am**. Aspen Street (The Northern Road end) will be closed and access for local traffic will be via Maxwell Street.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but every effort will be made to minimise impacts on residents by:

- Adapting our construction methods to reduce night work impacts as much as possible
- Changing work locations to minimise continuous impact on the same groups of residents
- Using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices and monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place at night to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and motorists. Detours will be in place during the road closures. See Map 1 and Map 2 for details.

Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.
