Out of hours work continuing on The Northern Road, South Penrith from Friday 5 October 2018

The Australian and NSW Governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is widening The Northern Road between Glenmore Parkway, Glenmore Park and Jamison Road, South Penrith and building a new interchange over the M4 Motorway at South Penrith.

As part of the upgrade, additional out of hours work will need to take place. Work on The Northern Road includes installing and adjusting barriers and signage, line marking, clearing vegetation, utility investigation and relocation work, potholing, asphaltting and building temporary lanes, retaining walls, road demolition and building new drainage.

On the M4 Motorway, night work will include building bridge structures, utility investigation and relocation work, line marking, clearing vegetation, building temporary access roads and concrete platforms, earthworks, building retaining walls, transporting equipment, installing and adjusting barriers and signage.

We have included a map to show the location of this work.

Our work schedule

To minimise the impact on road users, work will take place at night between **6pm and 7am** from **Friday 5 October 2018 to Friday 21 December 2018**, weather permitting. We may also need to work on weekends between **8am and 6pm on Saturdays and Sundays, weather permitting**. We will advise affected residents before this work starts.

During these months, early morning and late evening concrete pours may be needed as high temperatures can affect the quality of concrete. A few hours preparation may be needed before pouring but we will advise you before this work starts.

How will the work affect you?

Pedestrian access will change along The Northern Road. Temporary footpaths will be built between Bringelly Road and Jamison Road. Pedestrian access will be restricted between Frogmore Road and Bringelly Road.

During our work, every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses by:

- changing our construction methods to reduce night work impact - scheduling noisier activities in the earliest part of the shift, where possible
- alternating between work locations to minimise continuous impacts on the same community
- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices and monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

For the safety of motorists and workers, most of the work will take place behind concrete barriers. There will be some traffic changes and temporary lane closures which may affect travel times. At the intersection of Parker Street and Jamison Road, the existing traffic lights will be replaced with temporary traffic lights.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of signs and traffic controllers.


