Night work and traffic changes on The Northern Road, South Penrith from 7 September 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding this work as part of the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work along The Northern Road between Glenmore Park and South Penrith.

Utilities will be installed along The Northern Road between Frogmore Road and Bringelly Road, South Penrith.

To minimise the impact on motorists, work will take place over three nights **between 8pm and 9am on Friday 7 September (reopening Saturday 8 September), Saturday 8 September (reopening Sunday 9 September 2018) and Sunday 9 (reopening on Monday 10 September).**

The attached map shows the location of the traffic changes.

How will the work affect you?

We will be working along The Northern Road (Parker Street section) and using the stockpile site at the northern corners of Maxwell Street and Bringelly Road, South Penrith.

Our work may be noisy at times but every effort will be made to minimise impacts on residents by:

- using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices
- locating machinery away from residents, where possible
- turning off equipment when not in use
- monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and motorists.

The Northern Road (Parker Street section) will be closed between Frogmore Road and Bringelly Road. Detours will be in place via Tukara Road and Frogmore Road. Aspen Street (The Northern Road end) will also be closed with access for local traffic via Maxwell Street.

Traffic control will be in place to help residents access their properties.

Electronic message signs will also be in place to direct road users through these changes.


