




Night work and ramp closures on the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road, South Penrith

The Australian and NSW Governments are delivering the \$1.6 billion upgrade of The Northern Road between Narellan and South Penrith.

Roads and Maritime Services is building a new bridge over the M4 Motorway at The Northern Road, South Penrith. To minimise the impact on road users, some of this work will take place at night.

The Northern Road and M4 Motorway detour map and work location



The eastbound on ramp at the M4 Motorway interchange will be closed overnight at The Northern Road, weather permitting, on:

- **Friday 30 November from 10pm to 8am**
- **Saturday 1 December from 10pm to 9am**
- **Sunday 2 December from 10pm to 5am**

How will the work affect you?

Work includes earthwork, constructing drainage and road rebuilding, asphaltting, relocating street lights, installing and adjusting temporary barriers and signage, and line marking.

Our work may be noisy at times and will involve cranes, saw cutting, loading and unloading trucks and hand tools. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents by:

- Adapting our construction methods to reduce night work impacts as much as possible
- Using equipment fitted with noise mitigation devices
- Monitoring noise at night.

Traffic changes

Detours will be in place during the ramp closures which may affect travel times, please see the map for more information. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of detour signs and traffic controllers.
