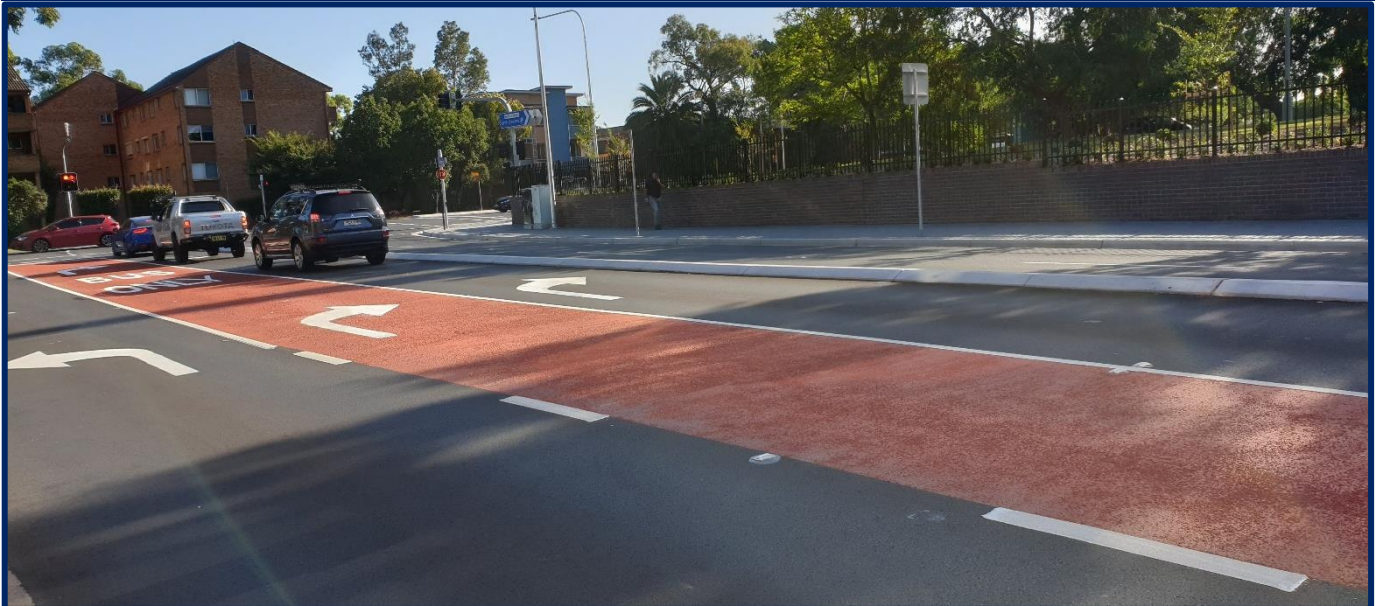


Bus Priority Improvements on Wilde Avenue and Victoria Road, Parramatta

End of Work | February 2021

Transport for NSW has recently completed improvements to the bus priority intersection at Wilde Avenue and Victoria Road, Parramatta. The bus priority intersection improvements reduce delays for bus customers and motorists as part of the NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program. The program is linked to the NSW Government's roadmap to deliver the state's future transport network, the Future Transport Strategy 2056.

Upgraded intersection of Wilde Avenue and Victoria Road, Parramatta



The work involved

- Installed a new dedicated right turn bus lane from Wilde Avenue northbound into Victoria Road to enable buses and vehicles to turn right at the same time.
- Widened the road at the eastern side of Wilde Avenue and the southern side of Victoria Road between Wilde Avenue and Elizabeth Street.
- Improved pedestrian facilities, including realignment of the footpath on the south east corner of Victoria Road and Wilde Avenue and the installation of new street lighting on Victoria Road and Wilde Avenue.
- Upgraded the drainage network on Wilde Avenue and Victoria Road, and installed new concrete kerb and gutter on Wilde Avenue.
- Resurfaced the road and repainted road markings on Victoria Road, and Wilde Avenue.
- Constructed a new retaining wall and safety fence on Wilde Avenue and replanted vegetation in the grounds of All Saints Church on Wilde Avenue.

Project benefits

- Improve the reliability of bus services and journey times through the intersection.
- Ease congestion and improve travel times for all road users, particularly during peak periods.
- Reduce crash risk by providing a separate bus lane and road widening.
- Provide more capacity at the intersection to cater for future growth in bus services.
