

## Site compound setup for Windsor Bridge replacement project, from Monday 20 August

The NSW Government is building a new Windsor Bridge to provide a safe and reliable crossing of the Hawkesbury River at Windsor.

Roads and Maritime Services will establish the site compound for the project on Wilberforce Road, Wilberforce, on the northern side of the Hawkesbury River, near Windsor Bridge. We will also create an additional area for stockpiling on the northern side of Wilberforce Road.

The site compound and stockpiling site will be established in line with Department of Planning and Environment approval provided for this facility.

The compound will be used for **the duration of the project**. Our standard hours will be between **7am** and **6pm**, between **Monday** and **Friday**, and from **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Over the course of the project, we may also work in the compound outside our standard working hours. Any work outside the standard hours will be carried out in line with project approvals and we will notify the community in advance.

The site compound will be used for:

- site offices for the project team
- amenities for workers
- storing containers and materials
- car parking for workers
- delivery of plant and equipment
- future construction of the bridge.

Work to establish the site compound will involve:

- installing fencing and environmental controls
- clearing and trimming vegetation where required
- creating entry and exit points for all construction and worker vehicles
- carrying out earthwork
- constructing site office and amenities, including parking and storage
- installing site sheds
- preparing the site for future construction activities.

## How will the work affect you?

There may be some disruption associated with this work including vehicle movements during the set up and use of this facility. Machinery and equipment used during the site construction may include trucks, rollers, mobile cranes, concrete trucks and equipment, power generators, hand tools and light vehicles.

We will make every effort to minimise impact to the local community and motorists in the area.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during the setup to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
